Cost of programme ↪

Scholarships are available to all NPQs for teachers and leaders working in the “top 50% of schools as defined by the proportion of students that attract pupil premium funding. You must also:

- be, or are aspiring to be, a senior leader with cross-school responsibilities.
- Work in a state funded school and state funded organisations that offer 16-19 places in England.
